

Porch Exterior Condition Assessment — Paint and Hardware

A walkthrough of a residential porch exterior identified three defect categories: peeling paint on the overhead soffit/fascia, missing door hardware, and widespread paint cracking along the house siding. All defects are on the exterior painted surfaces.

Soffit and Fascia — Paint Condition

The porch overhead soffit and fascia boards show significant paint failure. Multiple sections exhibit peeling and lifting paint, with curled flakes visible along the fascia edge.

The defect extends across the full visible length of the soffit, with paint separating in strips rather than isolated flakes.

Scraping and repainting of the soffit and fascia is required; substrate condition beneath the peeling paint should be assessed for moisture damage prior to repainting.

Door Hardware — Missing Components

The porch door is missing its handle set. A latch mechanism and a mounting hole are visible, but no handle is present on either face of the door.

Replacement hardware should be sourced to match the existing latch configuration.

Exterior Wall Siding — Paint Deterioration

The painted horizontal siding along the house exterior shows widespread cracking and paint separation. Cracks run horizontally along siding joints and vertically through individual boards.

The defect is present at multiple elevations and extends beyond the immediate porch area.

Full-surface scraping, priming, and repainting of the affected siding sections is indicated. The extent of bare wood exposure should be checked for weathering or rot.

Porch Column — Surface Condition

The painted porch column also shows surface cracking consistent with the siding defects. Vertical and horizontal crack lines are visible across the column face.

The column appears structurally intact, but the paint layer is failing and will require preparation and recoating.
